Work Trial – 5 days of work + one evening

This programme includes an introduction meeting at the Globe at 9am on the first Monday, 1 social evening and placements in local companies Monday-Friday (typically 35 hours per week). Work placements can include hotels, shops, community centres, offices and schools. Please understand that short placements in particular consist of basic tasks as there is little time for the training generally involved in more responsible and complex tasks.
